Following the service, a picnic buffet will be served at the Keeler's on East Bear - next to the Bear Island Yacht Club. We hope that many of you will be able to join us in this special celebration.

Also in commemoration of the anniversary, note paper carrying a picture of the Chapel has been printed and will be available at all services.

The Chapel will continue to offer regular 10 A.M. Sunday services throughout the summer. On this coming Sunday, July 10th Rev.
